**An impressive legacy dating back to the 16<sup>th</sup> Century**

Few locations in Rome can boast a history as prestigious as that of the **Hotel d'Inghilterra Roma - Starhotels Collezione**. It is beloved for its magnificent location, compelling history, eclectic originality and the effortless elegance with which it welcomes its elite clientele.

The building dates back to the mid-sixteenth century when it was used as an aristocratic residence for visitors of Palazzo Torlonia, located across the street. By the 15th century the local area was renowned for hosting the city's best hotels and attracted foreign visitors and international communities.



The nearby luxury shopping street Via Borgognona owes its name to the group of merchants from the region of Burgundy, who populated the district since the early 1400s. In 1845, Palazzo Torlonia's guesthouse was converted into a hotel known, due to its popularity with British visitors, as Hotel d'Angleterre.

One of the hotel's most famous residents was the English Romantic poet John Keats who spent time in the hotel during the last years of his tragically short life, together with his fellow countrymen Byron and Shelley. Even the hotel's logo, inspired by the coat-of-arms of the British Royal Family, is a testament to the deep-seated, centuries-old link that the hotel has had with Britain and the Windsors.

From the outset, the hotel has been frequented by aristocrats and celebrities, with the roll call of illustrious guests spanning from Franz Liszt and Hans Christian Andersen to Mark Twain and Henry James. Among the regulars were also Elizabeth Taylor, Gregory Peck and Ernest Hemingway during the years of "La Dolce Vita".

### **Hospitality at its best**

Years of history, art, intellectual dynamism and culture have forged the identity of this unique outpost of excellence. To this day, the Hotel d'Inghilterra is the choice of a refined international élite, drawn by the atmosphere, by its authentic Italian hospitality and by the interior design, at once timeless and original - all in the heart of Rome.

Hotel d'Inghilterra benefits from an enviable location in the historical centre of the Eternal City. It is situated near Via Borgognona, in the fashion district, just a short stroll from Piazza di Spagna with the legendary Spanish Steps and Piazza del Popolo. The Colosseum, the Pantheon and the mesmerising Roman Forum are all within walking distance, whereas for a leisurely stroll guests can head towards the lush, enchanting environs of Villa Borghese and the Pincian Hill belvedere.

The hotel's exclusive location makes it the perfect starting point for exploring the many archaeological treasures of Rome, its boutiques, cafés and restaurants. A dedicated concierge will provide tips on preferred itineraries and experiences and upon request will arrange exclusive tours of the Vatican Museums, Underground Rome, St. Peter's tomb and the Colosseum, as well as a chauffeur service for transfers to and from the airport, train station and city center.



Guests of the hotel can also take advantage of a wide range of 5-star hotel services, such as a Personal Shopper to guide and advice them through a private shopping experience.

### **Art, design and Architecture**

The stunning design of Hotel d'Inghilterra is the brainchild of the architects Alessandro Pasini and Tomaso Piantini whilst furnishings and fittings by designer Roberto Terrinoni decorate the fourth floor: chandeliers of hand-blown Murano glass, vibrant and elegant modern fabrics and with all the latest technology, from chromo-therapy showers to retractable TVs in the bathroom and, in one of the suites, a sauna.

The intimate sitting rooms – in orange, pistachio and powder rose nuances – are enveloped by the brilliance of the colours chosen for the walls and upholstery, which gave the rooms their names, and by the warm and cosy atmosphere created by the lamps, paintings and artwork from all over the world. Among the more interesting works of contemporary Italian art are sculptures by Roberto Almagno, ceramics by Giacinto Cerone and paintings by Franco Ruaro.

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## Rooms & Suites

Each of the hotel's suites is a perfect mix of traditional opulence and contemporary freshness embodying the soul of Italian design. ## Penthouse Suite

This elegant 80m<sup>2</sup> multi-level apartment comprises a sitting room, a dining area with a 19th-century fireplace, study, bedroom and two bathrooms in white Carrara marble. The paintings adorning the walls of the suite are originals by the famous artist Pinelli,

  
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while Imperial-style sofas, an oval Louis XVI table, Chinese porcelain lamps and antique carpets complete the decor.

This unique suite is located on the top floor of the hotel and it is famous for the generous private terrace, adorned with fragrant jasmine bushes and wild orange trees, and its magnificent views over the rooftops of Rome, sweeping from Villa Medici all the way to the Vittoriano. The 200mq terrace is also ideal for receptions, private parties or a romantic candlelight dinner for two.





### **Executive Suite**

Luxurious and functional at the same time, the Executive Suites measure 80 m<sup>2</sup> and include a sitting room, a dining room, a den with a kitchenette, a bedroom and two bathrooms with bathtub. The spacious bedrooms, tastefully furnished, welcome guests in a warm soothing atmosphere, while the living room, flooded with light, is perfect for reading and relaxing. From the terrace guests will enjoy a breathtaking view over Rome. One of the Executive Suites also comes with a separate room, ideal for private dinner parties or meetings, and another one has a sauna for perfectly relaxing moments.

### **Suite**

The Suites, each decorated in a different style, measure 45-60 m<sup>2</sup> and come with a bedroom and sitting room. The antique furnishings, handpicked so as to conjure a

sense of peaceful grandeur, make this the perfect place to enjoy the Eternal City.



### **Executive Junior Suite**
