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PARK HYATT MILAN

An oasis of sophisticated contemporary luxury

Park Hyatt Milan is an elegant five-star luxury hotel located in the historic center of Milan - a vibrant international city and the financial hub of Italy.

With an entrance on the discreet Via Tommaso Grossi, Park Hyatt Milan has direct access to the famous Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, one of the most recognizable symbols of the city. The Galleria, also known as “the parlour of Milan”, overlooks the square in front of the cathedral, another significant landmark of the city. The Galleria was returned to its original splendor after careful restoration and in 2017 celebrated 150 years of everlasting beauty since its inauguration.

The strategic location of the hotel is perfect for both guests on business trips and for those who want to discover the latest trends in fashion and design. The stock exchange and the financial district are just steps away, and the boutiques of the leading Italian and international brands are all concentrated in the so-called “Quadrilatero della moda” (or “fashion square”) between via Montenapoleone, via Manzoni, via della Spiga and Corso Venezia, all within walking distance of the hotel.

There is more to Milan than just shopping: art and culture are just as important. The many galleries and museums scattered throughout the historic center are filled with a lively exhibition calendar: Palazzo Reale, Museo del Novecento, Gallerie d'Italia and Pinacoteca di Brera are just some of these prestigious locations. Teatro alla Scala, the great temple of opera and one of the most coveted stages in the world, stands in the square adjacent to Park Hyatt Milan.

Situated inside a classic nineteenth-century building, Park Hyatt Milan was designed by architect Ed Tuttle. Since opening in 2003, the hotel has identified itself as the emblem of contemporary sophistication, integrating seamlessly into the urban fabric of the city while maintaining a strong international identity.

In the spirit of a classic contemporary style, the hotel's 106 sleek rooms and suites, spread over all six floors of the building, radiate elegance and enhance the original architecture and typical Milanese design. Neutral colors, travertine and choice textiles create a harmony that welcomes guests without pretension, and highlights the luxury of open spaces and natural light even in the bathrooms; extensions of the rooms themselves.

The most prestigious of the 25 beautiful suites of various sizes and categories are complemented by exclusive terraces which overlook the city skyline and were completely renovated in 2017.

The common areas of the hotel host the restaurant VUN Andrea Aprea, awarded a second Michelin star in 2018 and led by its namesake executive chef; Mio Lab, renowned for its Milanese aperitifs; and La Cupola, the beating heart of the hotel from breakfast to dinner.

Since the opening of the hotel, La Cupola has also served as a special showcase for prestigious artistic masterpieces, from the Head of Medusa by Lucio Fontana to Untitled by Anish Kapoor.

The Spa by Sisley is located in the basement and is an oasis of relaxation for the soul and the body. It is the only spa in the city to offer the famous treatments of its namesake French cosmetic brand.

LA CUPOLA LOUNGE

La Cupola Lounge is the heart of the hotel. The spacious environment is illuminated by the natural light streaming in from the 9 m tall (29.5 ft) glass dome towering above.

Thanks to its location, just a two-minute walk from the Milan Cathedral, Teatro alla Scala and Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, La Cupola is a welcoming place throughout the day for both hotel guests and residents of Milan. A recent restyling has further improved the elegant atmosphere and included an installation of mirrors which amplifies light and creates privacy for the central seats without isolating them.

La Cupola pays special attention to the interests of international clientele and offers comprehensive restaurant and café menus with generous breakfast options starting at 7:00 AM. Service continues with lunch and dinner specialties and an all-day menu until 1:00 AM, with the café menu available at all times.

All of the menus have been created by two Michelin-starred chef, Andrea Aprea.

The refined but deliberately informal lunch and dinner menus highlight the chef's creativity, and are a perfect combination of international flourish and a celebration of classic Milanese dishes. Acclaimed in its own right, the renowned Club Sandwich deserves a special mention and was named the Best in the World by Monocle magazine in 2008. Each season, Chef Aprea's menu includes his version of the original recipe alongside a creative variation, from vegetarian to barbecue. He continually transforms a hotel classic and a signature dish of Park Hyatt Milan.

The space becomes more intimate in the evening, with ambient lighting creating a refined atmosphere and offering another dimension of the dome's grandeur, now an extraordinary window under the stars in the heart of Milan.

MIO LAB & DEHORS

Located in the historic center of Milan, facing the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, Mio is one of the most renowned bars in Milan. It is a noteworthy locale for refined drinkers who return time and again to celebrate the great tradition of the hotel cocktail bar.

Mio stands out for its aperitifs every evening from 6:30 PM to 10:30 PM, and for after-dinner drinks. Every evening, a vibrant rhythm emanates from the spaces inside the bar, accented by the finesse of the barmen who are just as precise in executing the great classics as they are in the whimsical variations of the bar's signature cocktails.

A Bloody Mary here is not just any Bloody Mary: there are twelve original variations on the menu, based on organic tomato juice (both red and yellow), spirits and personal touches such as capers from the island of Pantelleria, celery foam or Dijon mustard.

A pinxtos selection created by two Michelin-starred Chef Andrea Aprea to accompany the drink list and complete the aperitif experience is available from 6:30 PM to 10:30 PM.

Dehors

The exclusive Dehors of Mio bar at Park Hyatt Milan is an irresistible temptation in Milan's city center. Situated on a street void of the typical city clamor, Dehors offers one of the most beautiful views of Milan: the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II.

As an extension of Mio bar during the warmer months, Dehors is the gold standard for cocktail lovers and the aperitif tradition.

At Dehors, using natural materials like teak is important in creating a sense of nature and comfort for the guests. The floral installation has been designed to survive all four seasons, with different blossoms and scents throughout the year: Mediterranean essences such as rosemary and myrtle, and flowers like camellia and azalea, grow both around the perimeter and on the terrace itself in handmade Tuscan terracotta pots.

From spring to late autumn, Dehors is the best location in the city to enjoy views of the famous Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II.

RESTAURANT VUN ANDREA APREA

The two Michelin-starred VUN Andrea Aprea restaurant is the ideal place to savor the art of fine-dining immersed in an ambience of pure elegance and sophistication.

The restaurant is located in central Milan, just in front of the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, and steps from the Teatro Alla Scala, Piazza Duomo, Via Montenapoleone and Via Della Spiga.

The name of the restaurant VUN in the Milanese dialect means "one", a name that express not only the close relationship that it has with the city of Milan, but also its desire to awaken feelings and emotions that are distinct in Milanese cuisine.

In 2014, in designing the revitalized space of VUN, architect Flaviano Capriotti focused on the unique gastronomic experience offered by Executive Chef Andrea Aprea. From this came the rebirth of a space in which food prevails as the central narrative; the refined furnishings, accessories, decorative elements play a significant role in accompanying the guest through their sensory experience.

Available for a more intimate experience, VUN offers a room for private events that comfortably seats 10 persons.

GUESTROOMS AND SUITES

Decorated according to the canon of contemporary classical style, the 106 guestrooms and suites at Park Hyatt Milan excel in original architectural and design details. Travertine has been used widely, featuring black inlays to give the marble greater depth. Special attention has been paid to the architraves, a distinguishing element in Milanese architecture.

The high ceilings are given greater prominence by imposts covered with precious apricot-colored silk. Every room is pleasantly spacious and features a relaxation area, a TV with satellite programming and high-speed Internet access.

The extra-large bathrooms mirror the discreet luxury that characterizes the entire hotel. They are bathed in natural light, and come fully equipped with deep walk-in closets, a safe and, unexpectedly, a mini bar. Each bathroom features a separate toilet, deep soaking baths and octagonal-shaped rain showers. Double sinks have bronze taps with black finishing touches.

Park Hyatt Milan has 25 splendid suites of varying dimensions and categories. Each Suite at Park Hyatt Milan has its own unique style: elegant and sophisticated, with precious materials such as carpets by Tai-Ping, rich fabrics by Jim Thompson – created exclusively for our Suites – and important art masterpieces.

The *Presidential Suite*, on the top floor of the hotel, is the hotel's most luxurious suite and is made up of between one and three bedrooms, a well equipped kitchen, a dining room and a huge living room, covering a total of 270 square metres (2,905 square feet). The suite also features a panoramic terrace furnished with travertine stone tables and sofas complete with oversize cushions.

The Presidential Suite hosts *Untitled*, a famous masterpiece by Tancredi Parmeggiani, a well-known Italian artist belonging to the Spatialism Movement (a concept that aims to expand the limits of traditional painting) and focuses on the interweaving of time and space.

Panoramic views of Milan welcome you to a 115-sq.-metre (1238 sq.-ft) *Duomo Suite* featuring living room with a collection of unique Chinese vases, dining for six, furnished outdoor terrace, kitchenette and marble bath with whirlpool tub and rain shower. Venetian stucco, hardwood floors and Italian marble accent the stylish decor.

Enjoy incomparable views over the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II's glass dome from a magnificent furnished terrace with a Jacuzzi covered in gold mosaic consisting of 50,000 pieces.

The terrace is also suitable for outdoor dining and entertaining.

The Imperial Suite, 175-square-metre (1,721-square-foot) space, has a spectacular design, with a 50-square-metre (538-square-foot) lush living room surrounded by precious art and design objects.

The Imperial Suite has its own bar, a dining room with a unique hand-made floor, created using an ancient Venetian tradition, that extends out onto a balcony, and a study furnished for every kind of business requirement and embellished with a curious collection of marble discs. A view over the city from the bedroom windows gives guests a glimpse of Milan's pulsating life, while a 50-square-metre (538-square-foot) in-Suite Spa combines the bathroom with a whirlpool bath, as well as treatment and fitness equipment, allowing guests to relax in the total privacy of this prestigious suite. Residents can discover interior well-being while enjoying the shower, enriched by chromo therapy in the form of a random play of different colors.

The Imperial Suite can be expanded to 255 square metres (2,205 square feet) if connected to the adjacent Park King Room.

The 90-square-metre (968-square-foot) *Ambassador Suite* features large sitting rooms, a bedroom with a seating area, large bathrooms and a separate Spa room, where well-being, facial and body aesthetic treatments can be performed in total privacy. The Suite also features a whirlpool bath, a chromo therapy steam shower and a small fitness corner equipped with a treadmill.

The Ambassador Suite is dedicated to those who want to transform a stay in the busy metropolis of Milan into a perfect and regenerating *remise en forme*.

Located on the top floor, the four 65 sq m (700 sq ft) *Terrace Suites* offer a breathless terrace overlooking the city, an intimate living area, enriched by hand-laid Venetian stucco, plush carpeting and uniquely created hand-blown Murano light fixtures. The bathrooms are bathed in natural light, and come fully equipped with deep walk-in closets, a safe, a mini bar, double sinks, a separate toilet, deep soaking baths and octagonal shaped rain showers. Enjoy the magnificent view from a private terrace for unforgettable moments underneath the Milanese skyline with its unique golden statue of Virgin Mary atop the Duomo Cathedral.

MEETING AND RECEPTION ROOMS

The first floor of the hotel has 240 square metres (2,590 square feet) of space available to host business meetings, private dinners or cocktail parties, all in the utmost privacy.

At 96 square metres (1,032 square feet), the Sala Duomo is the largest room, ideal for functions and dinners. It features precious walnut parquet floors, mirrors and a vaulted ceiling in silver leaf.

Measuring 48 square metres (516 square feet), Boardroom I is perfect for meetings and private business lunches. Featuring modern aluminium alloy and walnut windows, the room is accessed via a foyer with walnut furniture in terracotta and apricot colours.

To the side of the largest reception room is a smaller room, Boardroom II which feature walnut furnishings and is ideal for private meetings.

All meeting and reception rooms are bathed in natural light, and come equipped with high-tech multimedia equipment and broadband Internet connectivity or wireless access, which is also available in all public areas of the hotel.

PARK HYATT MILAN: A Building Steeped in Modern Milanese History

The *palazzo* that now houses Park Hyatt Milan was built between 1874 and 1875, the same period in which the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II was built.

Work on the 1,740-square-metre (18,722-square-foot) *palazzo*, designed by G. B. Torretta, was completed in 1875 and, for the next two years, was the *Comfortable* hotel.

Today, the building measures a total of 12,270 sq m (132,073 sq ft).

Documents of the time suggest that the 400-room hotel was refined, modern and much appreciated by its many guests, most of whom were businessmen. Its goods and baggage lifts were steam driven, and all floors came equipped with hot and cold water, and radiators. Lighting was provided by 900 gas lamps.

Some shops and workshops on the ground floor were rented out to third parties, and the entrance looked out onto what is currently Via Mengoni.

At the end of 1877, the entire *palazzo* was rented to the Bocconi brothers for 50,000 lira as its strategic location made it an ideal choice for their main store. In the beginning, the space was called “Aux Villes d’Italie”, but the French terminology proved unpopular with the Milanese and was changed to “Alle Città d’Italia” in 1880.

Selling furniture, clothing and decorative objects, the luxurious emporium was unique in Italy. On 27 April 1879, the *L’Illustrazione Italiana* magazine noted: “And who has not spent an hour or two walking about the ground floor, the mezzanines and the first floor? Who cannot admire the sense of order, the good taste, the opulence and the sheer quantity of goods on display? So many wonderful things to be seen – dresses from 8 to 400 lira, run-of-the-mill tea towels and splendid Flanders linen tablecloths ...”

The Bocconi brothers’ emporium remained on Via Tommaso Grossi for 12 years before work on the Bocconi *palazzo* – site of the present-day *La Rinascente* department store – was completed.
