Hotel De Lën opens in 2021 following a complete renovation of the Hotel Impero. Situated in the centre of Cortina d'Ampezzo, the new hotel will undertake a transformation not only structural but also conceptual.

The De Lën respects the highest standards of energy efficiancy and environmental sustainability, creating a concept of complete wellbeing that embraces all aspects of life.





The key concept is contemporary rurality, profoundly rooted in;

- Traditions of the surroundings (*for example the* elements in wood)
- Innovation and contemporaneity (*for example* elements in glass and exposed concrete)
- Sostainability *(for example building techniques)*





The new construction is composed of:

- 22 Suites and one Maxi Suite for a total of 48 guests
- The spa is located on the rooftop with views over the entire valley
- Restaurant and bar

True wellbeing is also linked to the sustainability of the spaces.

- All materials used in the Hotel are natural
- The proportions of the rooms have been studied to create the perfect balance
- The recirculation of air is constant without having to open windows, in order to reduce the energetic impact
- There are no animal hides used in the building

Hotel De Lën respects the highest standards of energy efficiency, sound proofing and healthy environments:

- It is the first Hotel in Cortina and the entire province of Belluno to boast the ClimaHotel certification
- The Hotel collaborates with the University of Primorska, in Slovenia, taking part in a research program, InnoRenew CoE (The Renewable Materials and Healthy Environments Research and Innovation Centre of Excellence).

A modern environment in harmony with the territory

Wood has always been the main material used in construction: builders, in order to recognize its origin would engrave the wood with their personal trademark. The name chosen for the hotel highlights this link with tradition.

You can reach the Hotel on either the A27 motorway (Venice-Belluno) or on the A22 motorway (Modena-Verona-Bressanone-Innsbruck). Motorway exits: A27 – Belluno: 72km A22 – Bressanone: 87km

The closest railway station is Calalzo di Cadore e Dobbiaco, there is a bus service provided from these stations to reach Cortina d'Ampezzo.
