CONCEPT

Satori merges the comfort of a five-star boutique hotel with a traditional hand-built wooden schooner to create the ultimate classic sailing experience.

Inspired by the understated elegance of the 1920s and '30s era with exquisite wood detailing and expansive window views, Satori features state-of-the-art living, dining and leisure facilities in a seamless design that amplifies the feeling of space and privacy on board, with various areas for guests to retreat to in intimate seclusion.

Satori was born of the passion and experience of designers Claus and Jeanette Thottrup, the dynamic duo behind the Borgo Santo Pietro Group of lifestyle companies, inspired by their love of sailing and ongoing quest to create experiences for guests that go beyond the bounds of the known to unite luxury and nature in a way that has never been done before.

Flawless service is therefore built into Satori's DNA, where guests enjoy Michelin-starred dining prepared by a personal chef from the Group's restaurants Meo Modo and La Bottega del Buon Caffè, onboard spa facilities, a range of the latest innovative water toys, and an extensive program of concierge activities managed by five-star boutique hotel and estate Borgo Santo Pietro. Each of the eight crew members have been hand-picked for their expertise, whether in navigation and seamanship, gourmet dining or five-star service, while Satori's two 600-horsepower engines offer guests the choice of both motoring and taking long-haul voyages as well as enjoying the timeless feeling of classic sailing.











DESIGN

Finished in glossy mahogany and walnut with teak floors, wood panelling and large windows throughout, Satori embodies the slow living and exquisite detail of classic bygone-era sailing.

Distinct atmospheres on deck

Claus and Jeanette Thottrup took their signature holistic approach to creating distinct atmospheres on board *Satori*, such as situating the open-view kitchen, bar and dining area mid-deck for greater privacy. Framed by large windows which offer sweeping views of the sea, the kitchen has been designed to inspire creativity for the chef within as well as invite the guest to actively observe the deft preparation of gourmet dishes.

A coffee lounge-style area on the aft deck with a second bar, comfy lounge seating and a large covered daybed creates a leisurely social ambience where guests can sip freshly brewed espresso coffee or a glass of wine. Satori's front deck is dedicated to cinema and solitude, with a state-of-the-art, fold-away cinema screen and large sunbed to enjoy the heat of the sun and gentle rise and fall of the waves. The top deck offers even more options for private sunbathing, with a row of sunbeds commanding spectacular views over the water, while old-fashioned deckchairs situated mid-deck add to the quintessential feeling of sailing upon the seas.






Wellness lies at the core of *Satori's* philosophy. From its carefully designed spaces that merge the best of nature and luxury, fostering good company and the sharing of solitude, to dining on the catch of the day, prepared with passion and fresh ingredients, a feeling of wellbeing permeates the guest experience on board.

Satori is not just about the design but how it is lived. The yacht's bespoke design enables guests to relax in intimate seclusion, with various decks offering separate spaces to enjoy shared company or retreat to for a moment of privacy. To maximise the feeling of freedom and privacy on board, the captain's wheelhouse and crew living and working areas are completely separate from the main guest areas.

Connection with nature permeates the experience on board, from the perennially visible views of the sea in the guest rooms, open-view kitchen and indoor living area, to the outdoor cinema that unfurls beneath the stars to provide high-tech down time while still maintaining a connection with the natural surrounds.

Satori also features a private wellness cabin fitted with a steam bath that can be converted into an extra guest room. Before sailing, guests can choose how they would like to use the space and arrange to have a personal therapist on board. A sanctuary for the senses, Satori's spa facilities enable guests to indulge in a revitalising treatment or soothing massage, topped off with a relaxing and healthy steam therapy at the end of a long salt- and sun-filled day.



Dining takes centre-stage on Satori, with a professional open-view kitchen, expansive mahogany bar and dining area situated mid-deck, where guests are able to watch their personal chef at work and dine in privacy while in harbour.

Managed by chefs from our Michelin-starred restaurants Meo Modo and La Bottega del Buon Caffè in Italy, the menu is tailored to local areas en route and ranges from light snacks to gourmet degustations, highlighting the catch of the day.

Guests not only have the chance to observe the open-view kitchen theatre as it unfolds but also become active participants. Satori offers guests the opportunity to indulge their gastronomic passion by taking cooking classes with the chef, using ingredients freshly harvested from the sea or hand-picked from local markets along the coast, drawing their inspiration from the sparkling sea viewed directly from the kitchen beach


Satori also features an air-conditioned, 250-bottle capacity wine cellar. Guests are invited to store their own wine in the cellar or pair their meals with a selection from Satori's outstanding collection of boutique wine labels.

TOYS

Blue-lagoon sailing starts right here, as Satori's telescopic swim ladder reaches straight into turquoise waters to a depth of 3-4m. Kids and adult alike find their playful side well catered for, with an enormous range of water toys on board and Gocycle G3 electric bikes for exploring on land.

Gocycle G3:

Make visits ashore more fun and relaxing with one of four Gocycle G3 electric bikes, the most cutting-edge e-bike available in the world to date.

Jet Tender:

A handsome 5.65m tender with a 180hp engine and sun cover, the Dieseljet 565 planes nimbly over chop, comfortably seating up to nine passengers.

Optimist Sailor:

Learn to sail in maximum comfort and safety with an Optimist sailor, great for kids and first-time sailors.

Water Skis and Wake Board:

Thrill-seeking guests can boost their adrenaline levels at sea by enjoying two of the most popular sports on the water, buffeted by the wind and doused in refreshing salt spray while being pulled over the shimmering waves.

Ringo:

A high-adrenaline diversion for friends and family alike, Ringo offers the thrill of waterskiing from the bouncy comfort of an inflatable float, pulled through waves and wakes all in the name of fun.

Guests will find everything they need to dive in and explore the underwater wonderland beneath the Mediterranean, including topof-the-range snorkels, masks and fins.

Jet Skis:

Normally used for competition, these superfast, high-performance Yamaha Superjet jet skis offer enormous scope for adventures on the water. Please note that certain regions may require a licence and allow the jet ski to be used in designated areas only.

Seabobs:

Power through the deep with two Cayago F5S Seabobs. These high-performance, easy to manoeuvre toys tow swimmers through the water up to a depth of 40m. *Please note that seabobs are currently* set to a safety depth of 2.5m.

Kayaks:

Explore hidden inlets along the coastline with three Feelfree Juntos kayaks. With additional space for a child or pet, this kayak is perfect for the paddler who wants to bring a partner along or simply enjoy some solitude.













THE CREW

The sailing crew lies at the heart of any memorable cruise, which is why Satori's eight crew members have been hand-picked for their expertise, whether in gourmet dining, five-star service or navigation and seamanship.

Satori's superb dining team showcases the talents of two chefs at all times: our resident gourmet head chef together with one of our executive or sous chefs from our Michelin-starred restaurants Meo Modo and La Bottega del Buon Caffè. Guests who would like to ensure the services of one of our Michelin-starred executive chefs on board may enquire about availability, as this requires special arrangement and may incur an additional cost.

Each of our stewards has been hand-picked from our five-star boutique hotel and estate Borgo Santo Pietro, joining our highly experienced hostess to ensure the utmost care of and attention to guests. The choice to increase the crew from a standard size of six to eight members with an additional chef and steward was made to ensure that guests receive the same five-star service offered at Borgo Santo Pietro while maintaining a sense of space and privacy on board.

Satori was built in collaboration with the boat's captain and Thottrup family friend Ali Aker, whose sailing experience spans more than 25 years on various types of boats throughout the Mediterranean, including 10 years at the captain's helm. A fluent English speaker, Captain Ali also shares his expertise as a free diver and night diver with guests, offering practical advice and assistance with the various water sports available onboard. Satori's first mate, engineer and deckhand share a great love of sailing as well as extensive experience, and have been involved in the Satori project from various stages.


