It is located on the edge of a 30-hectare forest on the sunny Tschögglberg plateau in the idyllic mountain community of Hafling, above Merano. Hafling has remained true to its original character, and especially here, in the small village of St. Kathrein, it seems wildly romantic and enchanting. Here you will also find the charming 13th century Romanesque church on a small hill surrounded by green meadows. From here, our guests enjoy a magnificent view of the mountain panorama. Even the journey to MIRAMONTI is an experience. A winding panoramic road winds its way from Merano up towards Hafling to reach this hidden gem. As an insider's tip, the MIRAMONTI appears reserved - as if you had just discovered something unprecedented for yourself. This house blends so unobtrusively into nature. Like a part of it.

Here, since May 2012, they have been realizing their long-cherished dream: to run their own hotel of a manageable size, impart their values to it and design it entirely to their liking.


Since buying the MIRAMONTI, they have been living casual chic, continuity, closeness to nature and proximity to their guests, day after day, with joy and passion.

MM 1932:

Preserving the tied and tested. Dare to try something new:

The MIRAMONTI looks back on a history rich of traditions:

In 1932, the house opened its doors for the first time as a small inn with three rooms. Later, in the 1950s, it was renovated from the ground up and transformed into a sought-after inn, which has since been listed in the Michelin Guide.

In 1984, it was converted into a residence and in 1998 it was expanded to a four-star establishment.

In 2005, the Panorama Restaurant was built with an incredible panoramic view of the city of Merano and the imposing mountains.

Merano and the imposing mountain scenery contributed decisively to the hotel's development. It has become a popular meeting place for gourmets, connoisseurs, and nature lovers.

In 2008, the transformation from a residence to a hotel took place.

The rooms and suites were renovated and, step by step, the entire building was given a new design.

In 2012, the new hosts Carmen and Klaus Alber celebrated the reopening of the house as a noble boutique hotel.

In 2019, the MIRAMONTI became a five-star establishment.

In 2021, the renovation of the entrance area and the Klassik restaurant takes place: Scandinavian interiors give the entire ground floor the desired restrained Nordic-Japanese flair.

In 2022: the complete renovation of the Roof Top Lofts and Loft 007 followed.

In 2024: New construction of the MONTI climate house with 3 private units. It's own Wine Cellar and underground parking space. 300 metres away from MIRAMONTI.

Architecture and rooms:

The exceptional five-star hotel embodies authenticity and naturalness. It was built in the style of the 1970s Alpine architecture, pleasantly unobtrusive and yet very present. The MIRAMONTI Boutique Hotel harmoniously adapts to its natural surroundings and has something of a hidden treasure. Indeed, as soon as you dare to take the first step into the hotel, you realize what lies behind it: a reduced, first-class design and a strong connection to nature. Both characterize the unmistakable style of the owner-managed boutique hotel. The entire hotel is designed in the Nordic style and is therefore attractive in winter as well as in summer. Above all, however, the unobtrusive luxury and the perceived hospitality of the Alber couple characterize this special Alpine gem. In harmony with nature and at the same time protected by it, it blends harmoniously into the idyllic landscape - something the Tara Architects team took very much to heart during all the renovations. The boutique hotel's 44 suites and rooms also offer peace and well-being. Open and bright gabled lofts, spacious double rooms, and especially large family rooms, all with a southern exposure, welcome the guest with a clear, linear style, contemporary technical equipment, and small attentions.

MM Cuisine:

Chef Massimo Geromel and sous chef Sergio Chinellato take care of the physical well-being. The chef, who is listed in the Michelin Guide and the Italian gastronomic guide, L'Espresso, spoils guests with culinary diversity. Always with a focus on authenticity and regionality, special emphasis is placed on the local origin of the ingredients used in the preparation of the dishes.

In the three restaurants under one roof, every guest will find what he or she is looking for:

The "Panorama Restaurant" lets the whole world take a seat. Alpine lifestyle, natural living, simplicity, and sobriety. Its view is an unforgettable natural spectacle. In an elegant and stylish ambience, guests enjoy light, Mediterranean and at the same time creative dishes. This is a place dedicated to fine dining. Not only the hotel guests appreciate this. Even among non-hotel guests, the gourmet restaurant is considered a real insider tip. The restaurant has been awarded two toques.

"Classic-Osteria Montana" is simple, to the point - Italian, in fact.

At the MIRAMONTI Klassik, guests start their day with a unique and simple breakfast. In the afternoon, at teatime, the hotel's own patisserie spoils hotel guests and external visitors. An exquisite selection of freshly baked and deliciously fragrant cakes, the popular South Tyrolean apple strudel and seasonal fruit sweeten the second half of the day.

In the warm season, when it is hot down in the valley, the home of the famous Haflinger horses has a wide range of activities ready: Nordic walking, horse riding, mountain biking, hikes to remote alpine pastures, challenging via ferratas and ambitious summit climbs fill the summer.

Brief chronicle:

1932 Construction and opening of the historic inn with three guest rooms by the Huber family from Merano.

1958 Extensive renovation work and listing in the Guide Michelin as a popular excursion destination and an outstanding inn with a unique view.

1984 Conversion into a residence with flats and a new restaurant

1998 Qualitative extension to the upscale 4-star Residence Hotel

2005 Opening of the Panorama Restaurant and renovation of the wellness area

2008 Change from a residence to a hotel with the renovation of the rooms and suites in a new contemporary design. The reception and bar area was also redesigned during this time and implemented in a timeless chic style.

2012 Takeover by Klaus Alber & Carmen Kruselburger.

Repositioning as a boutique hotel with 36 rooms: living hospitality through personal, tailor-made and discreet service Re-opening in May 2012.

2013 First major investment: conversion to pellet heating system

2014 Construction of Loft 007

2015 3 years MM: extension of the Owner's House, expansion and renovation of the spa area

2016 Completion of MM Spa and furnishing of Owner's House, expansion to 42 rooms

2017 5 Years MM: Construction Design Lofts & Q Suites with subsequent opening on 24 Dec 2017. Through the Secret Door, the Q-Suite is accessed via the handcrafted iron spiral staircase. Inspired by "Q", the inventor of 007, the new masculine suite on the ground floor is built on rock. Other features include Vitra design furniture, a walnut bar cabinet, wall panelling with hand-tanned leather, floors made of local porphyry stone and a balcony that juts out over the steep slope. The modern bathroom with walk-in rain shower offers a view of the city of Merano - showers with nature observation.

2018 Sustainable renovation in the main part of the MIRAMONTI with the architect duo Heike Pohl and Andreas Zanier. Complete renovation of MM rooms on the 2nd and 3rd floor.

Our 2018 project: a good decision in favour of products and materials from the forests, mountains and valleys of South Tyrol, often handcrafted by regional businesses and designed by and with people who look beyond our mountain peaks.

As a result, our hotel consists of 44 rooms divided into 22 categories and a total of 5 styles **2019** Acquisition of The Apartment (Lago di Garda), construction of the Sky House, Activity House and Onsen Pool.

2021 Complete renovation of MM Bar, Tea Room, Classic Restaurant and Panorama Restaurant
2022 Renovation of Rooftop Lofts and Loft 007, reception area and hotel kitchen
2024 Building of MONTI. 3 private units, built as a sustainable climate house. Just 200 metres away from MIRAMONTI. Suitable for 2-5 guests.
