The Palzzo, with walled gardens, gourmet restaurant and delicatessen now operates with all the services of a luxury hotel but still offering genuineness and authenticity for a small number of guests.

Historical notes

Palazzo Tiglio lies in the small hamlet of San Pancrazio, perched on a hilltop overlooking the magnificent Valdambra valley. This small village once belonged to the important Ubertini family of Arezzo before coming under the protection of the Marchesato di Bucine and the Grand Duchy of Florence

The current Palazzo Tiglio building was built in the 17th century on medieval foundations. When restoring the ancient cellars both a medieval water well and ancient grain storages were found, thought to be from roman times. Palazzo Tiglio lies in San Pancrazio, which stands on a hilltop crossing of the once important Strada dei Procacci. This was one of the major pilgrim and trade routes that connected the upper Arno valley with the southern part of via Lauretana towards Rome.

During the centuries Palazzo Tiglio has been owned by many notable and noble families, most recently the noble family Scodellini.

Palazzo Tiglio has been lovingly and painstakingly renovated by its new owners and decorated with antique furniture and artwork. John Werich and family look forward to welcoming you to Palazzo Tiglio and San Pancrazio. Palazzo Tiglio opened as a boutique hotel and gourmet restaurant in 2022, since 2024 Palazzo Tiglio is a member of Small Luxury Hotels of The World (SLH).

Dining

Welcome to the gourmet restaurant at Palazzo Tiglio, where you can enjoy the refined and delicous dishes of our executive chef Mattia Parlanti in an elegant and comfortable setting. Ingredients all come from local suppliers and from our own organic vegetable garden. We pride ourselwes with making everything in-house, down to the freshly baked bread, crackers and breakfast cakes. Our sommelier Danilo Salvi will guide you through our extensive wine list. In summertime our spacious terrace is the perfect spot to admire the sun setting over the Tuscan hills.

Breakfast is served buffet style in the main dining room and on the terrace; L'Orto bar in the garden servec apertivo in the evenings and our La Cantinetta delicatessen and coffe shop is open throughout the day, from the morning coffe and cornetto to lunch with cold cuts and pannini until the evening aperitvo or glass of wine.

The experience

Palazzo Tiglio lies in the heart of the aincient hamlet of San Pancrazio, an elegant oasis but still connected to the local village. Next to our reception lies "La Cantinetta" our village shop and café, the real heart of the village.

On the south side lies the main palazzo with the ground floor gourmet restaurant. On the Piano Nobile the lounge lets guests relax in the old salone of the palazzo with genuie fire places antique furnishings and frescoes. Here also lies our kitchen studio where cooking classes and wine tastings take place. Our Deluxe rooms are also situated on this floor.

Each of the 7 rooms and suites is unique, but all share the same attention to detail and the use of high-quality materials, antique furnishings and genuine artworks.

The elegant walled garden consists of three different areas: The pool area; with its pool and shady lounging areas under ancient olive trees, the formal rose garden with fountain and realxing sofas and easychairs and last lies the kitchen garden with L'Orto Bar, our small outide cocktial bar.
