Internationally-acclaimed fine dining restaurant, <u>II Fagiano</u>, was awarded a Michelin star in 2024 in recognition of an exquisite menu by Executive Chef Maurizio Bufi that combines the finest flavours and ingredients from Italy's northern and southern regions. Diners can choose from a selection of indulgent tasting experiences with wine and cocktail pairings, or opt for the à la carte menu, with creative and surprising dishes utilising the finest locally sourced produce with an emphasis on sustainability. Stand out choices from the 2025 menu include *Soqquadro pasta with roe deer, sprouts and truffle* and *Cartellata noodles with pike, smoked potato, capers and olives*.

At <u>Trattoria II Pescatore</u>, guests can savour breath-taking waterfront views while indulging in exquisite Mediterranean cuisine revisited in an international perspective by Executive Chef Pasquale Tozzi.
